- Each project committee must have at least 3 people involved in the project and have strong community support.
- Groups that would like to become a Project Committee should submit a "Project Committee Request Form" to the White River Council for adoption.

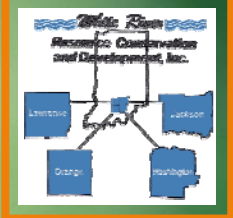
